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Research profile

I am Professor of Linguistics at the Department of Italian Language and Literature, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. My research interests focus on morphology, language variation and change, dialectology, dialectal typology, and language contact. I obtained my PhD degree in 2007, University of Patras (with a scholarship HERAKLEITOS funded by the European Science Foundation and the Greek Ministry of Education, under the supervision of Prof. Angela Ralli) and then awarded a one-year Post-doctoral Scholarship by the Greek Scholarships Foundation). I have worked as an Adjunct Lecturer at the Department of Philology, University of Patras, at the Department of Speech and Language Therapy, Former Technological Institute of Patras, at the Open University of Cyprus and at the Hellenic Open University. My experience also involves participation in the planning and implementation of a significant number of research projects on dialect documentation, description, and analysis of various Modern Greek Dialects (particularly for the varieties of Griko, Aivaliot, Lesvian, Cappadocian, Pontic, Turkish-Cretan, and the dialect of Megara). My publications address issues on the synchronic and diachronic study of Modern Greek and its dialects, based both on fieldwork and written sources. The focus of my research has been on the study of language variation and change and language contact emphasizing the morphological processes of diminution and augmentation, the combinability of derivational suffixes, the restructuring of nominal inflection, the integration of nominal and verbal loans, the study of perfective structures and the notion of morphological simplification vs. complexity in contact-settings. I have published findings of my research in leading journals including the *Language Sciences*, *Language Contact*, *Dialectologia* and *Geolinguistica*, *Morphology*, *Poznan Studies in Contemporary Linguistics*, as well as in edited volumes published by *John Benjamins*, *Mouton de Gruyter* and *Brill*. The last three years, I coordinated the [DiCaDLanD](#) research project aiming at the Digitization of the [Cappadocian Dialectal Landscape](#). Within this frame the last few years, my research interests center around the application of quantitative dialectological, i.e., dialectometric approaches to the study of linguistic diversity not only for the calculation of purely linguistic and/or geographical distances and their correlation but also regarding the consideration of extra-linguistic parameters.
